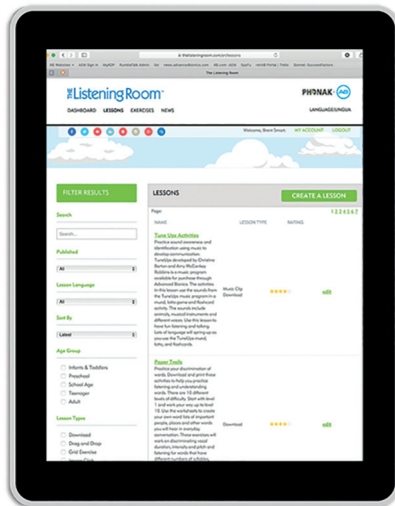

The Listening Room is an online resource that offers a library of interactive listening practice and activities. It also contains communication tips and resources for advocacy.

WHAT DOES IT DO?

It fosters the ability to discriminate sounds and speech more easily using self-directed activities to practice listening to sounds, words and sentences.
